Reception	<b>Self-Portraits</b>  Pupils will use draw and paint their own self-portraits.	<b>Collages</b>  Pupils will use a variety of materials to make collages. They will use scissors to cut their materials.	<b>Sculptures</b>  Pupils will use malleable materials to make a sculpture garden.
Year 1	<b>Wassily Kandinsky</b>  Pupils will explore primary colours and sketch and design their own painting based on the artwork of Wassily Kandinsky.	<b>Perfect Patterns</b>  Pupils will explore pattern work through finger and sponge painting.	<b>Making Models</b>  Pupils will use clay to make models.
Year 2	<b>Paul Klee</b>  Paul Klee's artwork is the inspiration for painting and colour work. Pupils will design and paint their own self-portraits.	<b>Batik</b>  Pupils will learn about batik and make their own designs.	<b>Natural Sculptures</b>  Pupils will research, design and make their own natural sculptures based on the artwork of Andy Goldsworthy.
Year 3	<b>Sketching</b> Pupils will develop their sketching techniques using a variety of tools and equipment looking at designers for inspiration e.g. James Dyson.	<b>Roller Printing</b> Pupils will use roller ink to print their own designs and look at graphic designers for ideas e.g. Milton Glaser 'I  New York'.	<b>Papier Mâché Designs</b> Pupils will research, design and make their own sculptures using papier mâché looking at furniture and building designs for inspiration.
Year 4	<b>Watercolours</b> Pupils will use watercolours to create detailed and intricate paintings using Claude Monet as inspiration.	<b>Collages</b> Pupils will investigate and make fabric collages with Van Gogh as inspiration.	<b>Modroc</b> Pupils will research, design and make their own sculptures using modroc and look at the work of Anthony Gormley.
Year 5	<b>Shading</b> Pupils will use graded pencils to develop sketching skills and look at Sage Gateshead for the changes in light.	<b>Patterns and Printing</b> Pupils will explore the fabric designs of William Morris and use this as inspiration to create their own printed designs.	<b>Sculptures</b> Moveable Models Pupils will use wires to sculpt and make moveable and malleable models using Leonardo Da Vinci as inspiration.
Year 6	<b>Perspective</b> Pupils will learn how to introduce perspective in their drawings and create a picture using the works of Vincent van Gogh, Claude Monet and Leonardo Da Vinci	<b>Embroidery</b> Pupils will design and make their own piece of embroidery.	<b>Movement</b> Pupils will use a variety of materials to design and sculpt human forms showing movement and look at how the Nike Logo was designed to capture this.
