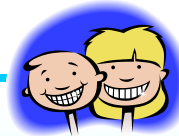




Welcome to Year 3/4



Dear Parents/Carers,

I would like to welcome back our Year 4 children and welcome Year 3 to our Year 3/4 class! I hope that your child enjoys the new challenges and approaches to learning that Year 3/4 has to offer. We are excited to be starting lots of new topics, **Light, Forces, Passport to the UK and Europe, Stone Age to Iron Age and Egyptians** and learning a new language (French) are just a few! Homework

Homework this term will go out on a **Friday** and please return it the following **Wednesday**.

Homework will focus mainly on key skills such as English, reading and maths tasks however if a project is sent home to be completed (e.g. for History), a much longer time scale will be given to ensure it is manageable for pupils and families.

Following success of previous years, homework will be set, returned and marked on **MS TEAMS**. Children's logins will be issued for Y3 and remain the same for Y4, they will receive a copy of this in the first week of term. Your support with homework is appreciated.

If your child is unable to access their TEAMS account at home for whatever reason, we will provide a suitable time in school for children to complete the tasks prior to the hand in date.



Reading



This year, guided reading will be completed throughout the week. This means your child will bring home a new reading book on the day they have guided reading sessions.

You are welcome to record any comments about your child's reading and return these to school to inform us of how your child's reading is progressing at home. I am happy to send additional books as requested. Children's reading levels will be reviewed in September and a coloured book-band will be allocated, which may be different to their previous colour band. **Children may receive the same book twice and this is to consolidate comprehension and word recognition skills.**

I will hear your child read in school each week in guided reading sessions and through whole class reading of our class novel. These sessions aim to provide more focused teaching of reading and comprehension skills.

It is vital that your child reads as much as possible at home, as well as in school, to make good progress, to improve comprehension, word recognition, spelling and to have fun!



PE

Year 3/4's PE day is **Monday**. Please ensure your child has a PE kit in school at all times with all items clearly labelled.

Please note earrings must be removed for PE lessons. Also, for the continued health and safety of our pupils, we are aiming to be an 'earring free' school. Your support in this is greatly appreciated.

After Y5/6, it will be Y3/4's turn to go swimming as their PE lessons. Please make sure your child has a towel, swimming hat and costume/trunks.

This year, **Year 4** will be taking a **Multiplication Tables check**, all children will be completing daily times tables tasks up to 12x12.

Homework will include Times Table Rock Stars set work. To ensure children are ready, if possible, parents are encouraged to support children in their preparation for this and practice as much at home as possible.
