Update on Your Child's National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP) Letter

Dear Parent / Carer

This letter is to inform you that the feedback letter for your child from the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP) is taking slightly longer to reach you than anticipated. We apologise for this delay.

The NCMP is a yearly check of height and weight for children in Reception and Year 6, helping us understand health trends and support families. Your child's measurement was taken at school, and the results are used to provide you with important information about their growth and local health services, as detailed in the original pre-measurement letter.
