Year 2	Paul Klee Paul Klee's artwork is the inspiration for painting and colour work. Pupils will design and paint their own self-portraits.	Batik Pupils will learn about batik and make their own designs.	Natural Sculptures Pupils will research, design and make their own natural sculptures based on the artwork of Andy Goldsworthy.
Year 3	Sketching Pupils will develop their sketching techniques using a variety of tools and equipment looking at designers for inspiration e.g. James Dyson.	Roller Printing Pupils will use roller ink to print their own designs and look at graphic designers for ideas e.g. Milton Glaser 'I ♥ New York'.	Papier Mâché Designs Pupils will research, design and make their own sculptures using papier mâché looking at furniture and building designs for inspiration.
Year 4	Watercolours Pupils will use watercolours to create detailed and intricate paintings using Claude Monet as inspiration.	Collages Pupils will investigate and make fabric collages with Van Gogh as inspiration.	Modroc Pupils will research, design and make their own sculptures using modroc and look at the work of Anthony Gormley.
Year 5	Shading Pupils will use graded pencils to develop sketching skills and look at Sage Gateshead for the changes in light.	Patterns and Printing Pupils will explore the fabric designs of William Morris and use this as inspiration to create their own printed designs.	Sculptures Moveable Models Pupils will use wires to sculpt and make moveable and malleable models using Leonardo Da Vinci as inspiration.
Year 6	Perspective Pupils will learn how to introduce perspective in their drawings and create a picture using the works of Vincent van Gogh, Claude Monet and Leonardo Da Vinci	Embroidery Pupils will design and make their own piece of embroidery.
